


2025-2026 Mid-Year Enrollment Still Open



Indoors Activities in the Winter

WINTER SURVIVAL: INDOOR FUN FOR UNPREDICTABLE WEATHER

The winter chill has officially arrived! As we face the unpredictable weather—and the inevitable days stuck indoors—I wanted to share a few low-prep activity ideas I used with my own children.

When my oldest two were preschoolers, I found that keeping a small "boredom buster" stash made all the difference. These items are easy to store and offer endless possibilities:

- The Basics: Painter's tape, construction paper, and a large roll of paper.
- Crafty Fun: Pom-poms, pipe cleaners, stickers, and dot paints.
- High Energy: Playdough, balloons, and glow sticks (perfect for "glow baths" or dark hallways!).
- The Classics: Paper lunch bags (for puppets) and those ever-present empty Amazon boxes.



GET MOVING!

- Indoor Obstacle Course: Use pillows, chairs, and blankets to create a path to crawl over, under, and through. You can even play "The Floor is Lava" to add some extra excitement!
- Glow Stick Dance Party: Turn off the lights, turn up the music, and let the kids move! Adding glow sticks makes a standard dance party feel like a special event.
- Scavenger Hunts: Hide a "stuffy" or a bear and play "Hot or Cold" to help them find it. Let the children take turns hiding the toy for you, too!
- Balloon Play: Try a game of "Keepy-Uppsy." It's a great way to burn energy without breaking anything!
- The "Add Water" Trick: The best parenting advice I ever received was: When things get rough, add water. Throw some glow sticks into a dim bathroom for a "Glow Bath"- it works like magic to reset a fussy afternoon.

PAINTER'S TAPE MAGIC

- Floor Tracks: Use tape to create balance beams, hopscotch squares, or car tracks across the carpet.
- Animal Rescue: Tape small plastic toys to a wall or sliding glass door and challenge your child to "rescue" them by peeling them off.
- Tape-Resistant Art: Place tape designs on cardboard and let the kids paint over them. Once dry, peel the tape away to reveal a masterpiece!




QUIET CREATIVITY

- Fort Building: Build a classic blanket fort and grab flashlights for a cozy "reading camp-out."
- Sensory Playdough: Add small plastic animals or cars to your playdough to create footprints and tracks.
- Paper Bag Fun: Create classic hand puppets or play "Guess What's in the Bag"- place a secret object inside and have your child feel the bag to guess what it is.
- Mural Making: Roll out a long sheet of paper (the Ikea rolls are perfect for this) and let them go to town with stickers, dot paints, and crayons.

Jumping into the new year with giggles, games, and lots of fun! Our little learners are keeping warm and busy this January with play, friendship, and smiles all around.
